

Eligibility

The Young Citizen of the Year Award is open to all persons who reside in the Loddon Shire aged up to 26 years as at the subsequent Australia Day.

Criteria

The main selection criteria are a noteworthy contribution to the local community during the current year and/or given outstanding service to the local community over a number of years, e.g. voluntary work (visiting elderly or disabled at home or in hostels; being involved in community projects – tree planting, tidy towns, Clean Up Australia; being involved in community organisations – Young farmers, Youth Groups, Fire brigade, Apex, Rotary, etc.; being involved in sporting organisations).

In addition, the following factors (not listed in priority order) may be taken into account, if applicable:

- contribution to family unit
- contribution to municipality, then state and national
- contribution to multi-cultural affairs
- community involvement with both male and female genders
- community involvement with both young and old

Detailed information

Please provide as much detailed information as possible, including a maximum of 3 references. This information is reviewed by the Loddon Australia Day Committee to assist in determining the award recipient.

Interview of nominators

The Loddon Australia Day Committee may interview each person nominating a candidate in order to seek as much information as possible to help in choosing the most deserving candidate.

Presentation of award

Subject to the receipt of suitable nominations, the award will be presented on Australia Day.

Re-nominations

Persons and/or groups nominated unsuccessfully in previous years may be re-nominated.

Selection

The recipient of the award will be selected by the Loddon Australia Day Committee.

The Loddon Australia Day Committee reserves the right not to grant any award or may grant more than one award for each category.
